## **Holocaust Memorial Evening**

On Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January, I was an extremely proud head teacher when our choir of 45 pupils sang at the <u>Neath Port Talbot Holocaust Memorial Evening</u> in the Great Hall, Swansea University.

This Holocaust Memorial Event marked the 80th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi concentration camp complex, and the 30th anniversary of the genocide in Bosnia.

This year's theme is 'For a Better Future', with the hope that by remembering the Holocaust and other genocides, we can learn and recognise future attempts to divide and discriminate against any groups.

The choir were a credit to the school and their families. Huge thanks to Mrs. Richards who organised the choir to attend and taught them the song, Bruno Mars' 'Count on Me'.

#### **Smartwatches**

A very few pupils are bringing smartwatches to school and are then recording using the device. This is a huge safeguarding concern for us as a school and I ask that children do not bring these recording devices into school. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

#### **Premises**

I have held a meeting with the local council regarding the proposal of a 3G pitch and Cruyff Court. Despite the Cymru Football Foundation and Cruyff Foundation very keen to pursue it, I have only received reticence from the local authority. I am awaiting a response to speak to the Director of Education and hope to do so early next term.

### **World Book Day**

We will be celebrating World Book Day on **Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March**.
